

Good at Googling

Thinking about key search terms will help you find the best answer quickly.

- cut out unnecessary words
- search for the words on you want to find in the answer
- choose words that describe what you need to find

What happens when you ask

Google:

- words don't stay together
- important words are missing
- several Tysons are shown
- *Google does not know what you are asking it*

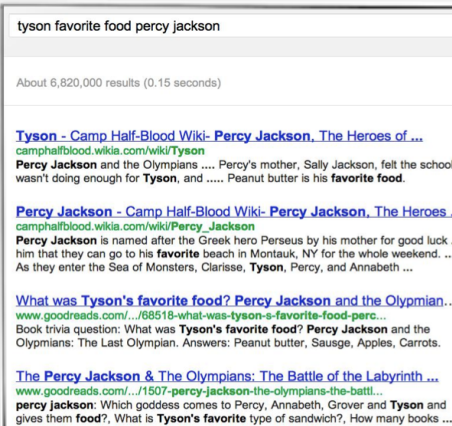
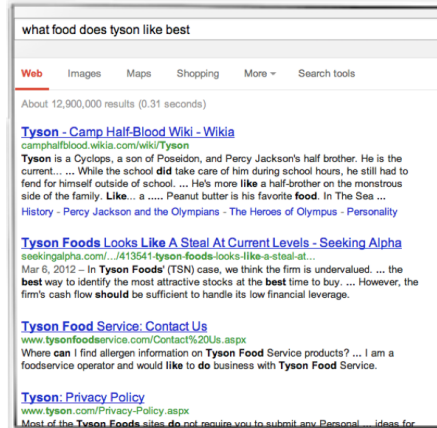
food Tyson like-best favorite

Question:

What food does Tyson like best?

What happens when you ask

Google:

- words don't stay together
